

Silver Lake Camp – What To Pack List

On registration day, please be prepared tell us who will be picking up your child(ren) from Silver Lake. All camps start at 2:00 PM and finish at 7:00 PM with the following exceptions:

1. River Wild will arrive at a normal start time (2:00 PM) and will leave at 11:00 AM on the last day.
2. Youth Camp will arrive at 4:00 PM and leave at 11:00 AM on the last day.

WHAT TO PACK *The following is a suggested list of “camping appropriate” items to pack for Silver Lake Camp.*

- T-shirts
- shorts
- long sleeve shirts
- sweater
- pants
- underwear, socks
- pyjamas
- bathing suit, beach towel
- jacket
- sun hat
- closed toe running shoes
- rain wear
- sleeping bag
- pillow, blanket
- flashlight & extra batteries
- insect repellent (**NO AEROSOL**)
- sunscreen (**NO AEROSOL**)
- water shoes or old running shoes for water games - Shoes should be secure to run in and out of water. Flip flops, slides, crocs are not acceptable. Keens or sandals that have a back strap are acceptable..
- old clothes for swamp walk - To participate, campers are required to wear long sleeve shirt, pants and closed toe shoes. Please pack clothing in a separate plastic bag clearly marked.
- personal hygiene items (environmentally-friendly products are preferred) pen, paper, stamps, Bible
- Water Bottle
